She was community. accepted as a health science major and gualified for admission to the Doctor of Physical Therapy 4+3 program. Our major concern was, and continues to be, how are we going to pay for this education? As her parents, we are willing to pay what we can afford to help her attend her dream school. However, based on the minimal need-based financial aid awarded, will have to fund the majority of her education. As it stands, we have a younger son who will be attending college in a couple of years and we need to balance our parent contributions so that each child has an equal opportunity to attend college.
