Hey Jocelyn!

I am doing extremely well! I've been here almost 7 weeks now. Hope your friend enjoyed Oktoberfest, I know I did. The third time I went I met up with a group of DSP Brothers from Colorado. Thus far, she has received over \$90,000 in scholarships. Of that amount, \$56,000 was a merit based scholarship through the private university she plans to attend (\$14,000 per year). She has received several national scholarships—AXA Achievement (\$10,000); National Honor Society (\$2,850); FFA Foundation (\$2,000), a couple of state scholarships—Kohl Excellence (\$10,000), Teen Court (\$500) and some local scholarships. She also has several applications pending, so the total amount may increase.
